Dear Dr. Jackson,

We saw China Singleton on 11/5/2007 for an ultrasound and MFM consultation. As you may recall, she is an 18 year-old female with an LMP of 4/4/2007 currently 30w5d EGA.

BACKGROUND/COUNSELING

I had extensive discussion with your patient regarding the current situation. We discussed the association of cervical length with length of gestation. We discussed the spectrum of abnormalities that include clear preterm labor on the one hand and clear incompetent cervix on the other. We discussed the limitations of her history in defining her current diagnosis. We also discussed the lack of good evidence showing benefit of surgical intervention in women without a clear history of an incompetent cervix. I summarized the respective data regarding cerclage placement in patients such as her as well as the recent prospective reports on prospective trials including their findings and limitations. I attempted to answer her questions. We discussed extensively the potential risks and benefits of cerclage placement vs. expected management/bedrest and I discussed McDonald vs. Shirodkar cerclage including potential risks and benefits of each as well as my reasoning for the preference of the latter if we ultimately perform a cerclage.
