There is a horizontal tear of the medial meniscus which reaches the tibial articular surface.

Cruciates and Collaterals:

The MCL is a little thickened which would be consistent with an old sprain.

Bone/Muscle

There are no apparent fractures, contusions, muscular injury, or effusions.

Impressions and Recommendations

- 1) Horizontal tear of the medial meniscus
- 2) Thickened MCL consistent with old sprain
