Findings

Scrotum

Scrotum

An extratesticular cystic mass 2.0cm x 3.0cm in size is identified in the left scrotum. The cystic mass is in the head of the epididymis of the left testis. This most likely represents a spermatocele/epidendymal cyst. This most likely represents a benign lesion. The right scrotum is normal.

Impressions and Recommendations

Abnormal mass of left scrotum with homogenous cystic mass noted on sonogram most likely spermatocele/epididymal cyst. Normal Right Scrotum General Ultrasound exam.
